DIRECTIONS

From Iowa and other points southwest

- 1. East on 180 to US 61, go north thru Dubuque
- Cross bridge, it's 60 miles to Boscobel and another 12 miles till WI 171 west.
- 3. Take 171 six miles into Gays Mills, at bank bear right onto WI 131 North, community center is 1.3 miles

From MN and other points northwest

- Cross the Mississippi on US 14 to reach La-Crosse
- Follow US 14 south, when it splits take US 61 south to Soldiers Grove, then follow WI 131 south to reach the Gays Mills Community Center (red roof) on right

From the east

- 1. From Madison take US 14 west to WI 60
- 2. Follow WI 60 west to US 61
- Then go north on WI 171 west six miles into Gays Mills; at bank bear right onto WI 131 North, community center is 1.3 miles
